Through this work, he found God calling to him in a special way and he entered the Carmelite order and became a priest. At John's first Mass, he met Teresa of Avila, the great reforming saint and nun who desired the Carmelite nuns to pursue lives of holiness. Her words inflamed his heart to seek holiness as Teresa described and he worked to reform the Carmelite friars. He dedicated his life to founding Carmelite monasteries under his reforms. But John's life was filled with suffering, as he followed the way of the Cross, his namesake. John experienced the deepest consolation and the mystical union of his soul with God in prayer.
