Inside the Church - the TABERNACLE

Along with the altar, the most important object in a Catholic church is the tabernacle. The tabernacle is the repository where the Eucharist is kept – Jesus truly present in the consecrated hosts. Some of these consecrated hosts are for Communion to the sick. As God made himself present to the Israelites in the desert in a tent, the word tabernacle literally means "tent".

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that the tabernacle "should be located in an especially worthy place in the church". In most Catholic churches, the tabernacle is located just behind or near the altar. Some churches have a small chapel reserved for the tabernacle. A tabernacle is made of non-transparent material. It is immovable and kept locked so that the Blessed Sacrament cannot be stolen or desecrated.

The Catechism tells us that "the dignity, placing and security of the Eucharistic tabernacle should foster adoration before the Lord really present in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar." **Because we believe that Jesus is truly present, Catholics should genuflect or bow before the tabernacle, as a sign of reverence.**
