STRENGTH IN WEAKNESS

The Gospel tells us that Jesus is hampered from performing miracles in Nazareth because of the people's lack of faith. Jesus is said to be surprised by this. This passage unfolds a continuing theme in Mark's Gospel: Who is Jesus? Jesus found people were too close to him to have faith in him, his words and his work. Amazed at their lack of faith, he felt the strength of his weakness. By showing that Jesus himself was rejected, Mark's Gospel prepares us to accept this possible consequence of Christian discipleship.
