## St. Ignatius of Loyola – July 31

*A patron saint for difficult times.*

When Ignatius of Loyola found himself bedridden with a shattered leg, all of his big dreams and plans were history. Ignatius was a soldier to his core, and he excelled on the battlefield. His journey gives us a battle plan for navigating our own dead ends. A sudden end can be a new beginning. What had initially seemed like the end of all his dreams suddenly became the door to a totally new life. Inspired by the fervor of the saints, Ignatius immediately began an intense regimen of prayer, sacrifice and poverty. The insights he gained in contemplation became his famous *Spiritual Exercises*. The Jesuit order began as a group of university friends whom he gathered together to pray these “Spiritual Exercises.” Whether making hard choices, recovering from unexpected events, going through physical sickness or spiritual darkness, “pray as if God will take care of all; act as if all is up to you.”
